

Character Role-Play Project

- **Assignment:** The main character is the glue that holds any story together. You will become that character. Portray your characters habits, attitude, wording, etc. to make the character believable to the class. You will have 4 minutes to present the main character of the novel you selected. If you go over 4 minutes, your teacher will stop you. Make every second count.

Here are some questions to help guide your thinking:

- How is the main character portrayed?
- What was the ultimate goal that your character wanted for himself/herself? How did you character go about achieving this?
- How did you character use his/her actions, words, deeds, etc. to achieve his/her ultimate goal?
- What does your character need most?
- What emotion does your character evoke in others?
- What about you is heroic (or anti-heroic)?
- What is your greatest strength as a person?
- What is your greatest weakness?

You will be graded on:

- Believability
- Length of role-play (3-4 minutes)
- Clear idea of all aspects of the character
- Dressing, sounding and acting like the character

Due Date is May 19th – 20th!

Pre-AP:

Adopt a character's personality and interact to a new event in a manner that is consistent with the character developed by the author.

- Presentation needs to be 3-5 minutes
